



# Frequently Asked Questions

## 1. Can we pre-enter? If so, how?

Yes, you may pre-enter. You will need to download and fill out the entry blank from our website. Fill out the entry blank; enclose check or credit card information, and copies of the horses' registration papers and membership cards. The entries will need to arrive at our office no later than Monday, August 15, 2011. Our mailing address is Reichert Celebration, PO Box 380, Williamsburg, IA 52361. Physical address for UPS/FedEx is Reichert Celebration, 600 Court Street Ste 1, Williamsburg, IA 52361. If you pre-enter and cannot show, refunds will be made after the show with a vet certificate and/or doctors note.

## 2. In the high point section you have "Must show in respective halter division to qualify (10 & under excluded). Do you mean the non pro and youth halter classes? Does it include the non pro and youth hunter in hand classes?

Yes, this requirement means the non pro or youth exhibitor must show in their respective Halter class (Halter, Most Colorful, or Hunter in Hand). All non pros (novice, 35 & over, masters, and non pro) must show in one of the non pro halter classes (including color) or non pro hunter in hand classes. All youth exhibitors (13 & under & 14 to 18) must show in one of the youth halter classes (may include color or youth hunter in hand classes). The youth 10 & UNDER walk/trot is exempt from this rule.

## 3. If I show in both non pro halter and non pro hunter in hand, will both classes count to the high point? If I am a youth and compete in youth halter and youth hunter in hand will both classes count to the high point?

If the non pro or youth chooses to show in both the halter and hunter in hand classes, both classes will count in the high point calculations. In fact, all classes will count if they are a youth class.

## 4. Will charge cards be accepted? If so, which ones?

We will accept Visa, Master Card, Discover and American Express.

## 5. What papers will I need to bring to the entry booth?

You will need to bring a copy of the horses papers, coggins test (TX rules apply to all), a health certificate, (TX rules apply) and Appaloosa membership cards. Remember the ApHC requirement that both the owner and exhibitor must be an ApHC member.

## 6. If I show in the NSBA dual approved classes or the NSBA approved futurity classes, what do I need?

If entering any of the NSBA classes you will need owner and exhibitor NSBA cards or a copy of both cards. If you wish to save time at the entry desk, please bring copies you may leave behind. We can make copies at the entry desk.

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**7. May I buy a regional ApHC club membership at the show?**

Yes, Appaloosa Regional club memberships will be available at the Appaloosa entry area.

**8. May I buy a national ApHC club membership at the show?**

Yes you may buy a national ApHC membership at the show.

**9. I recently bought my appaloosa and have sent the papers in to transfer this horse to my name. I do not have the papers back yet. May I still show?**

You may show the horse with a copy of its registration papers and a copy of the transfer, but you will need written confirmation from the ApHC that the transfer is in process and they will allow the horse to show.

**10. May I add or delete classes after I have made my initial entry? Is there any penalty for doing this?**

Yes, you may add or delete classes, but it must be done at least 2 classes before that class enters the arena.

**11. I'm the only entry in a class; can I scratch at the gate? Will there be a penalty if I do?**

You will need to check with the gate person before the class enters the ring. If you are the only entry and no one else has added, then yes you can scratch with no penalties. Please see #10

**12. Will there be a photographer taking photos during the ApHC classes?**

Shane Rux Photography will be onsite throughout the entire show, taking arena and other pictures. Please contact them when you arrive if you wish special arena pictures.

**13. Will anyone be taking videos of the ApHC classes?**

Yes all arenas will have a videographer. You will need to check with Video Horse World if you want a personalized video. Their phone number is on [.ReichertCelebration.com](http://www.ReichertCelebration.com)

**14. Will the ApHC show be available for viewing online?**

Yes, all 3 arenas will be webcast

**15. I have come for the Appaloosa breed show and decide to stay longer than I originally bought my stall. If I want to show in a Reichert class later in the week or just watch the rest of the show, how much extra will my stall cost?**

It all depends if there are stalls available. Please check with the stalling office upon arrival.

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
